The following decisions were taken at the meeting:

1. The following areas/ facilities were identified for renovation: Library, Chemistry Lab, Agriculture Labs, Cabins in College Office, College Canteen and the Ceiling of Post-graduate Library. It was also decided to mobilize funds by contacting noted Alumni of the college.
2. Organization of at least one National and one International Seminar would be planned. For this purpose, Research Proposals would be sent to funding agencies.
3. College Website was proposed to be re-vamped.
4. The College would apply to RUSA for grant, as and when, the portal opens.
5. Participation in India Today- MDRA Rankings in B.A., B.Sc., B.C.A. and B. Com.
6. It was decided that Tutorials for all classes be organized.
7. Workshops for Fine Arts, Home Science and Fashion Designing be organized.
8. At least one classroom to be converted into ICT- enabled classroom in the present session to make learning Learner- centric.
9. Augmentation of Sports Facilities be done.
10. Students be taken for Placement Drives/ Recruitment Fairs organized by other institutions or by Punjab Government.

## Action Taken Report

1. Proposals were sent to noted Alumni for this purpose and a sum of INR 28 lakh was generated for Renovation of college library and Chemistry laboratory. Repair and renovation of College Canteen, Ceiling of PG Library and cabins in Administrative Office were redone.
2. An International Seminar on *Contemporary Trends in Punjabi Literature* was organized by PG Department of Punjabi, and the Department of Economics organized a National Seminar/ Webinar on *Sustainable Development Goals*.
3. College Website [davchsp.org.in](http://davchsp.org.in) was revamped as planned.
4. The institution submitted a proposal to RUSA for a grant of INR 2 crore.
5. The participation in India Today –MDRA Survey saw a marked rise in the position of the college in B.C.A and B.A. We maintained our position among the Top 100 colleges of the country, securing Rank 35 in B.C.A, 60 in B.A., 78 in B. Com. and 82 in B.Sc.
6. On the basis of a Schedule prepared after deliberation, Tutorials were organized for all classes wherein special emphasis was laid on Personality Development.
7. The departments of Home Science, Fine Arts and Fashion Designing organized Workshops conducted by experts from other institutions and the products thereof were displayed in Exhibition cum sale.
8. Room number -2 in the Arts' Block was equipped with Projector, White Board and Internet connection. *Teaching with Technology Fortnight* was observed in order to make learning more student- centric and participative.
9. To augment Sports' facilities, two Lawn Tennis Courts were created in Multi- purpose Sports Complex. A Yoga workshop was conducted for the benefit of staff- members.
10. Students were taken to Placement Drives conducted by nearby educational institutions.
