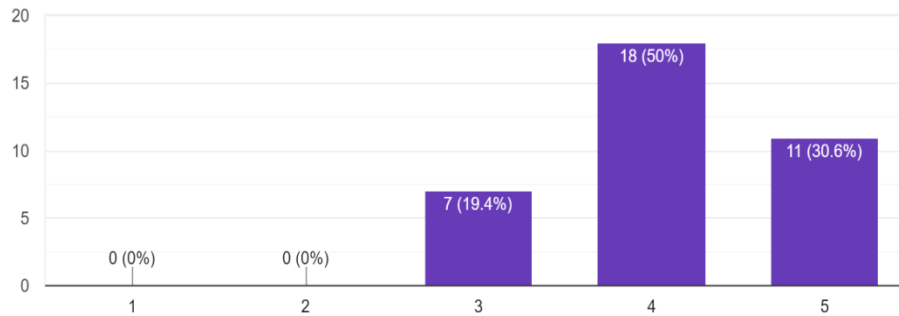


Feedback Analysis Report of Faculty for the Session 2020-21

1. The curriculum is as per the need of the students

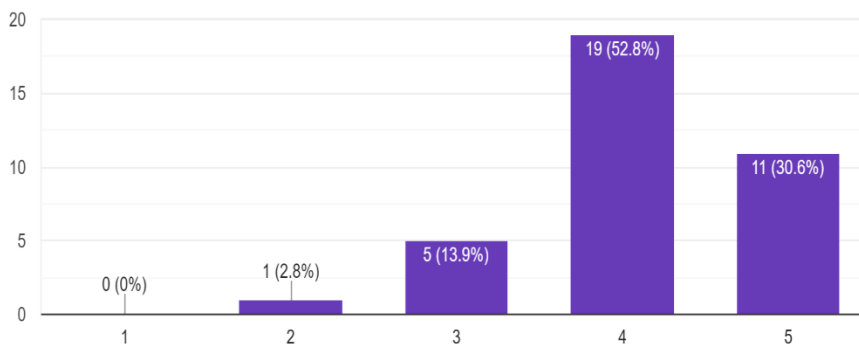
36 responses

2. The contents of the course are in conformity with the learning outcomes.

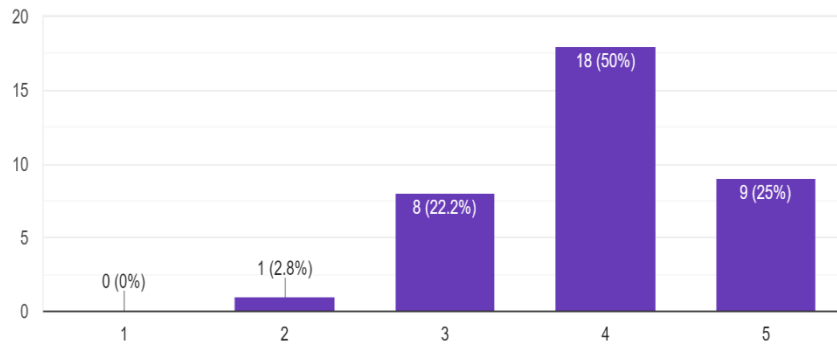

3. The curriculum is balanced with regard to the theoretical and practical knowledge.

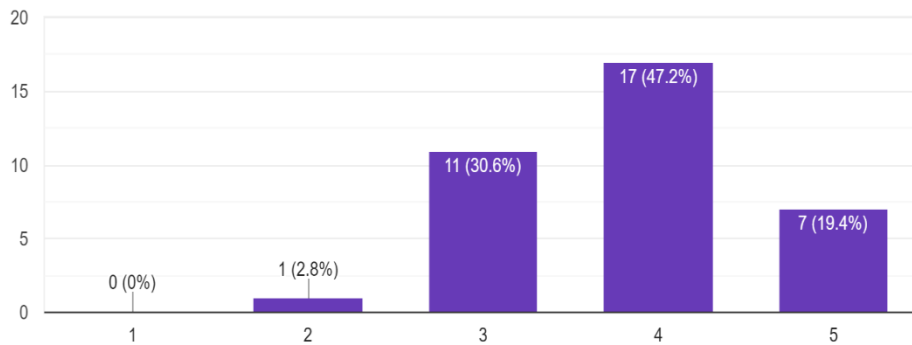

4. The curriculum has the potential in developing the habit of self learning among the students.

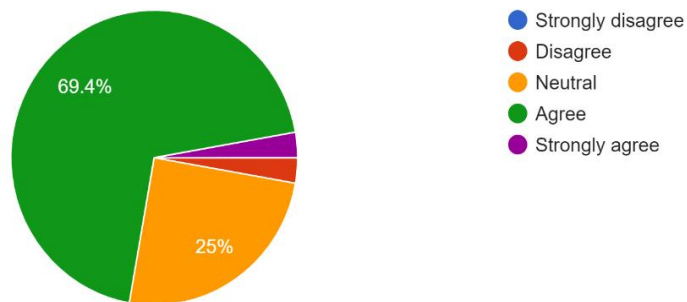

5. The curriculum development procedure needs improvement.

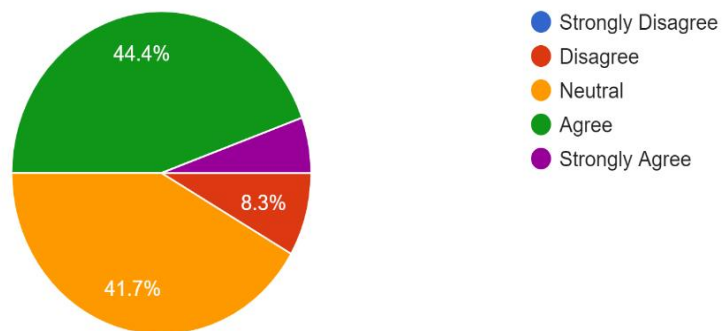

6. The curriculum has focus on skill development.

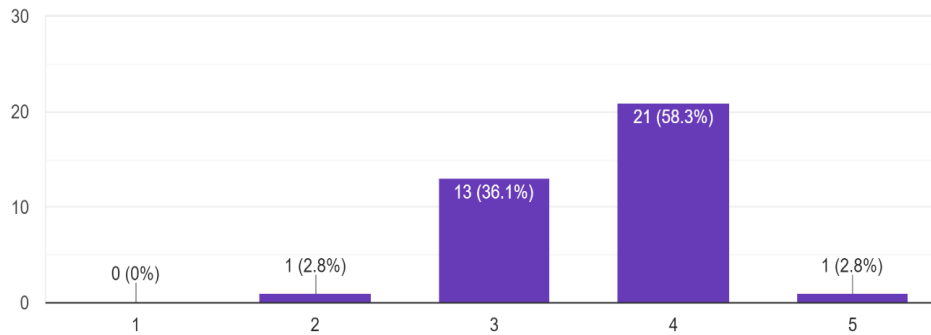

7. Pedagogy proposed in the curriculum matches the contents

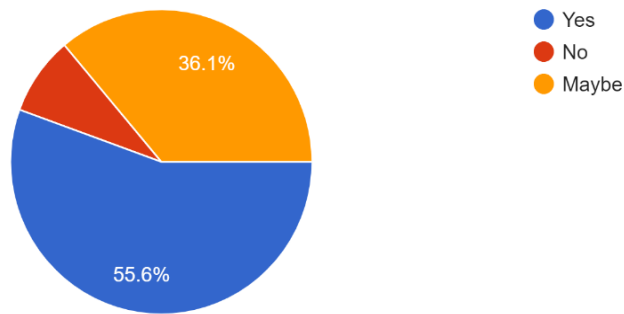

8. The evaluation methods mentioned in the syllabus are sufficient for providing proper assessment

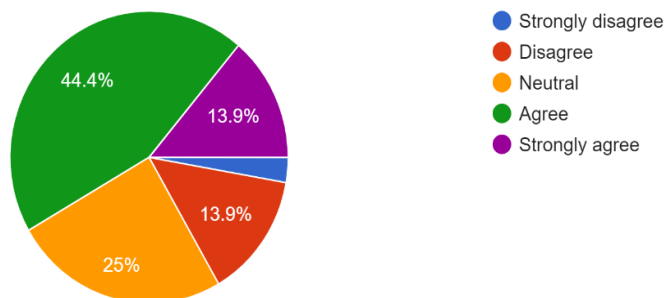

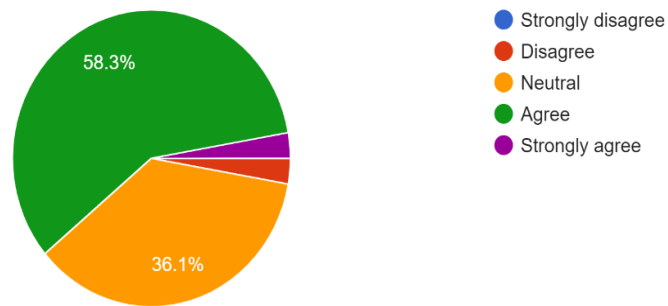
